

OFFICIAL RULES

The filmmaker must be a CADL cardholder.

All short films must be written, directed, and edited by teens ages 13-19.

Entries may be either a group project or an individual work.

Adults are permitted to act in and assist in your film. While adult guidance and instruction are also permissible, the planning and production must be executed by the teens.

Films may be on any topic, but must be G or PG rated in language and subject matter or they will be disqualified. Films will be previewed for content.

Title pages and credits should be included in your film.

Please do not include bloopers in your film, unless they are relevant to the plot.

Films may not exceed 3 minutes in length, including credits.

The use of sound or video clips from other films, television shows, music videos, etc., within your entry is not permitted — UNLESS those clips are in the public domain OR you have received written permission from the copyright holder.

The use of copyright-free, public domain, trade-friendly, or creative commons copyright music is allowed. Filmmakers may also use their own original music. To use copyright music, however, filmmakers must obtain permission from the copyright holder.

Each filmmaker may submit one film.

- Use the work for not-for-profit CADL fundraising and promotions
- Include or embed the work in another film (not-for-profit) produced by the CADL Film Festival, such as a collection of films to be used to promote the Film Festival
- Display the work, in part or in its entirety, on the CADL website (not-for-profit)
- Display the work, in part or in its entirety, on the CADL UnCanned Facebook page
- Present the work to the public by any means, including but not limited to: Internet, cable, radio, television, newspapers, VHS, CD, and DVD
- Have the work listed in our catalog of entries
